Over the years, he played with several bands including but not limited to: The Goodie Band, Black Explosion, Organist Rhoda Scott, the Clarence Spady Band, J. T. Carter of the Crests, High-Strung, several gospel groups and musicals including Jesus Christ Superstar, and many others. While these bands represent a wide range of genres from R&B, Blues, Rock, Jazz, Country and Gospel, Kamau's love is old school R&B along with classical Rock. He took a long hiatus from playing but started back playing a few years ago. During the break, he became a college professor and author. He currently teach at Northampton Community College and also teaches drumming at the Antfarm Music store in Mt. Pocono.









John Strauss - Keyboards

Originally from and currently residing in Hellertown, PA. he also called State College, PA, Beaver Falls, PA and Clifton Park, NY home.

John began playing the piano at age 4 and took up the trumpet in elementary school, playing through high school as a member of the concert, marching, and stage bands. His first keyboards were Hammond and Farfisa organs (both of which he still owns today) which he carted around playing with a couple of rock bands during the high school years. Playing



music took a backseat when he went to college (the Hammond wouldn't fit in his dorm room) and then "life happened". Inevitably, the music bug bit again and bit hard and he was fortunate to find *Flirtin' With The Mob* in need of a keyboard player.
